

Annex 1

Annex 1 amends the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between Forschungszentrum Jülich (JÜLICH) and Shota Rustaveli National Science Foundation (FOUNDATION), signed on 16th of June 2015 at JÜLICH, Germany.

Referring to Article I paragraph (2) of MoU (elaboration joint research and educational program) JÜLICH and FOUNDATION (hereafter parties) agree the following with the goal of conducting dedicated Autumn Lecture Courses (QUALI-Start-Up Science Lectures) and Summer Schools (Georgian-German School and Workshop in Basic Science (GGSWBS)):

Article 1

Parties jointly agree on equally co-fund Summer Schools (Georgian-German School and Workshop in Basic Science (GGSWBS)) or Autumn Lectures (QUALI-Start-Up Science Lectures) respectively in every year: the Autumn Lectures shall take place at JÜLICH in the corresponding successive "odd" years (in 2017 and 2019), the Summer Schools will be held in Georgia in the corresponding successive "even" years (in 2018 and 2020).

FOUNDATION will fund both events: Summer Schools and Autumn Lectures. Budget per event is up to 15.000 EURO, which include the following:

- a. Air fare and lodging for a maximum of 20 Georgian students and Universities Consortium coordinator, participating in the Autumn Lectures at JÜLICH;
- b. Air fare, local transportation, lodging and meals for JÜLICH scientific staff members, participating in the Summer Schools as lecturers.

JÜLICH will fund both events: Summer Schools and Autumn Lectures. Budget per event is 15.000 EURO, which include the following:

- a. Air fare and lodging for JÜLICH staff members for the Autumn Lectures' preparatory work (students' selection assessment) performed in Georgia;
- b. Local expenses for Autumn Lectures at JÜLICH for a maximum of 20 students including costs for local transportation, meals, lab consumables, etc.;

- c. Air fare for JÜLICH scientific staff members participating in the Summer Schools in Georgia.

Article 2

- a. JÜLICH and FOUNDATION agree, that FOUNDATION transfer their rights to the Georgian Universities Consortia (Iv. Javakhishvili Tbilisi State University, Georgian Technical University, Ilia State University, Agricultural University of Georgia) to organize the events and the selection process of the participating candidates. The skill set of the candidates must be agreed upon prior to the official announcement of the training courses by the parties.
- b. JÜLICH agrees that the Georgian Universities consortium coordinator takes the responsibility to ensure the financial clearance for the FOUNDATION.
